Manage My Health Patient Portal

Courtenay Medical now requires all patients to sign up with Manage My Health. You can then book appointments online, order prescriptions, view test results etc.

To book a same day / urgent / nurse or specialised appointments you will still need to phone through to reception. All other routine 15 minute GP appointments should be booked online either through your Manage My Health App or our website using the easy booking button.

The registration process is quick and easy. All you need is a personal email address, proof of identity and to be 16 years or older.

Once you've registered you can access your medical file from home, the office or on your smart phone, anywhere, anytime!

Repeat Prescriptions

Please remember to order your prescriptions before you run out as your request takes time to process. Same day prescriptions incur an additional charge.

Courtenay Medical policy requires all patients to have a medication review annually with their GP.



Repeat prescriptions will only be available to request via your Manage My Health App or in person at the practice by completing our repeat prescription form at reception. Our prescription phone line will cease from 1st April 2020.

Coronavirus

Recently, an outbreak of a new coronavirus disease now called COVID-19 was identified. Coronaviruses are a large and diverse family of viruses which cause illnesses such as the common cold, severe acute respiratory syndrome (SARS) and Middle East respiratory syndrome (MERS).

Symptoms include: Fever, Coughing, Difficulty breathing

Difficulty breathing is a sign of possible pneumonia and requires immediate medical attention.

Keep well while travelling overseas

Cover your coughs and sneezes

Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze, or you can cough or sneeze into your sleeve. Throw used tissues in a lined trash can, and immediately wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds making sure you dry them thoroughly. You can also use hand sanitiser.

Wash your hands

Wash your hands often and thoroughly with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. You can use a hand sanitiser if soap and water are not available and if your hands are not visibly dirty. Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
